1. Who is eligible to apply for the Nature and Me \$50 Contest?

Students in grades 5 through 11 are eligible. Teacher does not have to be a member of LAD to submit this essay.

2. Give each student a packet including: Guidelines, Application Form, Scoring Rubric.

3. Share this information with your students:

- o Writing will be in the form of essay.
- o Give your students topic options that align with your course content and relate to the natural world. Please DO NOT assign one essay title, since an important part of the writing process is for students to reflect on what they know and care about, to think for themselves, and to decide what they want to share through their writing. To help students get their own ideas for writing, you might pose questions such as these: What do you think, feel, or know about something in Mother Nature? What have you experienced in nature that has affected your life? What is a problem facing nature and what do you think will help solve it?
- o Submissions should be one to three pages in length; typed; 12-point; stapled.
- o The Scoring Rubric is included to help students self-check.
- o Students should complete the Application Form and paperclip the essay to it.
- Students should submit their Application Forms with essays to you by the deadline.
